

D. New Agenda

1. Swine Breeders

Mr. Gesto said that out of 29 heads of piglet being sold 23 were already paid amounting to PHP 46,200.00. The other 6 heads are account receivable. He also added that the 5 heads sow was already bred.

2. Commonal Garden

Ms. Charo Sombilon principal of Bitanhuan Elem. School ask the farmers to cultivate again the the area at the back of the school. She said that she would be happy if that area become productive. So it can give benefits for the school, the association and the barangay as well. So, the members agreed to start cleaning the area this coming Saturday February 5,2022.

3. Swine Rehabilitation Program

Mr. Gesto informed the members that the swine rehabilitation program wherein the association will receive a number of feeds from the provincial agriculture office were ready to deliver. He said that we need to buy 25 heads piglet for the project, since we can't provide a piglet from our Breeders.

4. Other Matters

- a. Arneil says that all scheduled groups for feeding, he will be responsible in giving feeds for the pigs every morning, group members need only to clean the premises and to fed late in the afternoon.
- b. Members must bring "kawayan and bugsok" to be used in constructing the nursery.
