MINUTES/PROCEEDINGS:

1. Purpose of the Association and renewal registration of Association

The meeting currently presided by Mr. Mario Y. Piañar (SAMIFA President), he discussed to the group the entire aim and purpose of the association. Mr. Pianar said that while waiting for the positive opportunity of our new Governor's, lets continue planting of vegetables as a source of livelihood to our association as well as our members. He added that the tractor is well functional and managed.
