AN ORDINANCE ENFORCING **ANTI-STRAY** THE DOG ORDINANCE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MATAG-OB, LEYTE AND THEREBY IMPOSING FEES, CHARGES AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Matag-ob, Leyte, in its regular session assembled, that:

Section 1. Short Title. This Ordinance shall be known as the anti-stray dog ordinance of Matag-ob, Leyte.

Section 2. Definition of Terms. The following terms shall be defined accordingly:

- a. Stray Dog a domestic animal that has a established pet owner which have strayed from their owners and wandering about;
- b. Street Dog may be stray dogs, pets which have strayed from or are abandoned by their owners;
- c. NO CONTACT POLICY is a policy that allows identification and determination of ownership of stray dogs as well as the utilization of CCTV, digital cameras and/or other gadgets or technology to capture videos and images to apprehend owners of stray dogs.
- d. Citation Ticket a form issued to person/s violating any municipal ordinance of the municipality in lieu of arrest or prosecution, among other things, it notifies the offender/s on the particular infraction of the ordinance he/she violated and also advices him/her to appear before the Chief of Police.
- e. Trespassing enter the owner's land or property without permission.
- f. Euthanize put a living thing specially a dog to death humanely
- g. Adoption the action or fact of taking legally the ownership of a pet dog
- h. Auction a public sale in which a dog is sold to the highest bidder.

Section 3. Scope. This ordinance shall cover the territorial jurisdiction of the municipality of Matag-ob, Leyte.

Section 4. Registration of Dogs. The Office of the Municipal Agriculturist shall be tasked to effect a municipal wide registration of dogs in consonance with the provisions of existing laws on Rabies Control.

Section 5. No Contact Policy. Is a policy that allows identification and determination of ownership of stray dogs as well as the utilization of CCTV, digital cameras and/or other gadgets or technology to capture videos and images to apprehend owners of stray dogs.

How does it work?

a. The PNP shall identify the owner of stray dog, after which, a citation ticket shall be issued against the owner of the stray dog;

b. The Punong Barangay and other authorized Barangay Officials shall also take full responsibility in identifying the owner of stray dogs in their respective barangays;

c. To ensure the efficient and effective implementation of this ordinance, the Barangay Officials shall then be deputized to issue Citation Tickets to violators of this ordinance.

d. After receiving the citation ticket, the owner of the stray dog shall then be given Five (5) Working Days to pay the administrative fine to the Municipal Treasurer's Office.

No other office shall be authorized to receive payments except the Municipal Treasurer's Office.

Section 6. Dog Bite Accountability. If a pet dog is involved in dog bite incident, then the owner and/or possessor of such pet dog shall be liable to shoulder the expenses incurred for the treatment of the dog bite victim.

In cases wherein the dog bite incident is due to trespassing, then the land owner and/or property owner is free from any liability/accountability.

Section 7. Barangay Share from Administrative fines. The Barangays comprising the municipality of Matag-ob shall be given 60% share from the income generated from administrative fines paid by violators of this ordinance.

Section 8. Formulation of Implementing Rules and Regulations. The Office of the Municipal Agriculturist in coordination with PNP, Office of the Municipal Health and other line agencies shall be assigned to formulate the Implementing Rules and Regulations so that a mechanism shall be established for the supervision, monitoring and reporting for the effective and efficient implementation of this ordinance.





Section 9. Impounding of Stray Dog. Only dogs that have no established and/or identified owner will be impounded and put in the dog pound.

- 1) The impounded stray dog shall be kept in the dog pound for Five (5) days, after which, it shall be disposed of in the foregoing manner, whichever is applicable if no owner comes forward to claim the dog:
 - a. Auction off with a starting bid of Two Hundred Pesos (P200.00), each bid increment shall be not less than Twenty Pesos (P20.00);
 - b. Adoption:

- c. Euthanize
- 2) Pet owners whose pet dog is detained in the dog pound shall be caused to pay an impounding fee of P50.00 per head per day in addition to the administrative fines that the pet owner must pay for violating the provision of this ordinance.

Section 10. Establishment of Dog Pound. A dog pound shall be established to house stray dogs that will not be redeemed by their respective owners immediately, or those dogs that have no established owner.

The dog pound shall be designed in coordination with the office of the Municipal Engineering, the Office of the Municipal Agriculturist and the Office of the Municipal Health.

It shall be manned and operated by a personnel hired by the LGU for the purpose and the personnel therein shall undergo the trainings to capacitate him of his official duties and functions.

Section 11. Adoption Process. Adoption process for stray dogs housed in the Municipal Dog Pound.

- a) Submit an application for adoption;
- b) Go through an interview with the Dog Pound Administrator;

The Dog Pound Administrator shall be delegated to formulate and reproduce the Adoption Application Form.

Section 12. Auction Process. Before the start of the auction, potential buyers shall be allowed a preview period to check the dogs on sale and examine their condition. The preview period may be announces as being on the day of the auction, a few hours before it starts. Once potential buyers are done viewing all the dogs for auction, they must register with the auctioneer. The registration process requires the buyer's details like phone number, address and a valid identification card. Each registered bidder shall be given a bidder card with a number that is used to identify the participants.





The auction shall then start with the auctioneer giving a brief description of the dog for sale and starts the bidding at P200. The bidders will now call out their price. Each bid increment shall be at P20.00.

The process ends when there are no more bids, and the buyer making the highest bid gets the dog on sale. The highest bidder takes ownership of the dog immediately after paying his bid price.

Section 13. Euthanization for dogs. Euthanasia is an overdose of barbiturates that will stop a dog's heart. The fluids are administered through an intravenous catheter or an injection and it si painless when properly done, hence, before administering the barbiturates, the dog should first be given sedatives to calm the dog.

This procedure shall be administered by an expert in coordination with the office of the Municipal Agriculturist and the Municipal Health.

Section 14. Penalty Clause. Any person found violating any provision of this ordinance shall be penalized as follows:

a. First Offense - a fine of 500

b. Second Offense - a fine of 1,000

c. Third Offense – a fine of 2,000 or imprisonment of Five

(5) days, or both such fine and imprisonment upon the discretion of the court.

Section 15. Separability Clause. If for any reason, any provision of this ordinance is found unconstitutional or contrary to law, the other provisions not affected thereof shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 16. Repealing Clause. Municipal Ordinance No. 76 s. 2018, entitled "AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING FEES AND CHARGES FOR OWNERS OF ASTRAY ANIMALS AND FOWLS WITHIN THE POBLACION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MATAG-OB, LEYTE.", is hereby modified accordingly.

Section 17. Effectivity Clause. This ordinance will take effect 15 days upon approval.


