

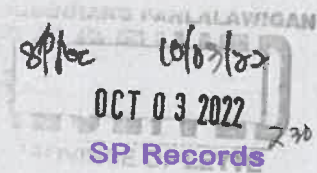

**Dear Vice-Governor Javier, Jr.:**

Pursuant to Section 22(c), Chapter II, and Section 465(b)(1)(vi), Chapter III, Article 1 of the Local Government Code of 1991, this Office most respectfully requests the Honorable Sangguniang Panlalawigan for the issuance of a **RESOLUTION** authorizing, among others, the Governor and/or the Provincial Administrator to represent the Province in all cases to be filed by Province of Leyte and/or filed against the Province of Leyte, before any court, tribunal, quasi-judicial office, to wit:

- 1.) *To initiate and file any case, and represent for and on behalf of the Province of Leyte;*
- 2.) *Sign the Verification and Certification of Non-Forum Shopping;*
- 3.) *Appear for and on my behalf of the Province of Leyte, at all stages of the proceedings, including hearings of whatever motions or pending incidents involved in the action;*
- 4.) *Enter into an amicable settlement or to submit any case to other alternative modes of dispute resolution;*
- 5.) *Decide for and on behalf of the Province of Leyte, on matters*



*involving simplification of the issues in the above-mentioned case;*

- 4.) *Decide for and on my behalf of the Province of Leyte, on matters involving the necessity or desirability of amendments to the pleadings; and other matters, such as:*
- 5.) *The possibility of obtaining stipulations or admissions of facts to avoid unnecessary proof;*
- 6.) *The limitation on the number of witnesses;*
- 7.) *The advisability of a preliminary reference of the issues to a commissioner;*
- 8.) *Determining the propriety of rendering judgment on the pleadings or summary judgment or of dismissing the action should a valid ground therefore be found to exist;*
- 9.) *The advisability or necessity of suspending the proceedings; and*
- 10.) *Such other matters as may aid in the prompt disposition of the action."*

Your expeditious consideration of the matter is highly appreciated, as the same is considered urgent.
