COMMITTEE REPORT

No. ____ S. 2022

This is with reference to the letter, dated July 8, 2022 of Honorable Octavio J. Traya, Jr. and Honorable Lemuel Gin K. Traya, Mayor and Vice Mayor of the Municipality of Abuyog, Leyte, respectively.

The letter seeks to follow up the status of Municipal Ordinance No. 18, series of 2020 and Ordinance No. 02, series of 2021, both entitled as "An Ordinance Adopting the Mechanism for the Grant of Sangguniang Bayan Resolution to Application of Industrial, Commercial Sand and Gravel Quarry Imposing Fees, Charges and Penalties for Violation Thereof." The latter being an amendatory ordinance after complying with the observations of the Provincial Legal Office and the Sangguniang Panlalawigan.

In relation thereto, the Mayor and Vice Mayor of the Municipality of Abuyog, Leyte, inquired if they could already implement and enforce the aforementioned ordinance.

Perusing the records on file and the sequence of events which transpired, it was disclosed that the only concern left which requires a clarification from the municipality of Abuyog was the legal basis of Sec. 6. of Ordinance No. 2, Series of 2021. This section requires the payment of fees before a Mayor's Business Permit is issued, which is quoted as follows:

"Sec. 6. Issuance of Mayor's Business Permit. The office of the Municipal Mayor thru the Municipal Business Permit and Licensing Office shall issue a Mayor's Business Permit with the corresponding amount to be collected:

- 1. *Mayor's Business Permit
To Industrial Sand and Gravel
Quarry Operations* - *Php 20,000.00/year*
- 2. *Mayor's Business Permit
To Commercial Sand and Gravel
Quarry Operations* - *Php 10,000.00/year*
- 3. *Mayor's Business Permit
To Filling Materials (Boulders)
Concessionaire* - *Php 10,000.00/year*
- 4. *Mayor's Business Permit
To Filling Materials (Mountain Soil)
Concessionaire* - *Php 10,000.00/year*

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All fees shall be payable to the office of the Municipal Treasurer of this Municipality.”

In order to address the concern about the legal basis of the fixed fees contained in Section 6 of Ordinance No. 2, series of 2021, the Committee on Rules, Laws and Privileges communicated with the Sangguniang Bayan of Abuyog, through Vice Mayor Honorable Lemuel Gin K. Traya and consequently, Resolution No. 31¹, series of 2022 was issued by the concerned Sanggunian, articulating therein the basis of the fees contained in Section 6 of the subject ordinance.

Noticeably however, the basis articulated in Resolution No. 31 only refers to the consensus it made with concerned individuals and concessionaires through a Public Consultation made for that purpose. In addition, the same was also made to amend the old rate of Business Permit on Sand and Gravel in the amount of P2,500 under their old Revenue Code. In the effort of the Committee on Rules, Laws and Privileges to address the concern in relation to the legal basis of such imposition of a fixed Mayor’s Business Tax under Sec. 6 of the subject ordinance, the committee was able to observe and study the following related provisions of the Local Government Code, as follows:

SEC. 130. Fundamental Principles. - The following fundamental principles shall govern the exercise of the taxing and other revenue-raising powers of local government units:

(a) Taxation shall be uniform in each local government unit;

(b) Taxes, fees, charges and other impositions shall:

- (1) be equitable and based as far as practicable on the taxpayer’s ability to pay;*
- (2) be levied and collected only for public purposes;*
- (3) not be unjust, excessive, oppressive, or confiscatory;*
- (4) not be contrary to law, public policy, national economic policy, or in restraint of trade;*
- (5) The collection of local taxes, fees, charges and other impositions shall in no case be let to any private person;*
- (6) The revenue collected pursuant to the provisions of this Code shall inure solely to the benefit of, and be subject to disposition by, the local government unit levying the tax, fee, charge or other imposition unless otherwise specifically provided herein; and,*
- (7) Each local government unit shall, as far as practicable, evolve a progressive system of taxation. (Emphasis Ours)*

It is worth to note that under Sec. 130, par. b (7) of the Local Government code, LGUs are enjoined as far as practicable to adopt a progressive system of taxation, hence in relation thereto the Code provides in

Section 143, a schedule of fees based on the gross sales or receipts of a certain business, providing thereof the corresponding fees to be collected. Otherwise stated, the imposition of a business tax shall not be a fixed rate, but must be based on a graduated schedule of fees based on the gross income of a business.

For reference, par. a, b and h of Sec. 143 of the Local Government Code is quoted hereunder as follows:

SEC. 143. Tax on Business. - *The municipality may impose taxes on the following businesses:*

(a) *On manufacturers, assemblers, repackers, processors, brewers, distillers, rectifiers, and compounders of liquors, distilled spirits, and wines or manufacturers of any article of commerce of whatever kind or nature, in accordance with the following schedule:*

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(h) On any business, not otherwise specified in the preceding paragraphs, which the Sanggunian concerned may deem proper to tax: Provided, That on any business subject to the excise², value-added³ or percentage⁴ tax under the National Internal Revenue Code, as amended, the rate of tax shall not exceed two percent (2%) of gross sales or receipts of the preceding calendar year. The Sanggunian concerned may prescribe a schedule of graduated tax rates but in no case to exceed the rates prescribed herein. (Emphasis Ours)

The business on sale or operation of a sand and gravel, quarry and distribution of filling materials clearly are not included in the enumeration under Sec. 143; however, pursuant to par. (h) of the same section, the LGUs may impose a Tax as it may deem proper, hence they may be allowed to impose a business Tax on the business of sand and gravel, quarry and distribution of filling materials; however, there shall be a prescription of a schedule of graduated tax rates and shall in no case exceed the rates as prescribed in Sec. 143.

The imposition of a fixed rate therefore under Section 6 of Ordinance No. 2, series of 2021 of the municipality of Abuyog lacks the legal basis pursuant to the aforementioned sections of the Local Government Code.

² Excise Tax is a tax on the production, sale or consumption of a commodity in a country. It applies to goods manufactured or produced in the Philippines for domestic sale or consumption or for any other disposition; and to imported goods.

³ Value-Added Tax is a business tax imposed and collected from the seller in the course of trade or business on every sale of properties (real or personal) lease of goods or properties (real or personal) or vendors of services. It is an indirect tax, thus, it can be passed on to the buyer.

⁴ Percentage Tax is a business tax imposed on persons or entities who sell or lease goods, properties or services in the course of trade or business whose gross annual sales or receipts do not exceed P550,000 and are not VAT-registered.

And because of the said findings, the Committee on Rules, Laws and Privileges conducted a committee meeting on September 15, 2022 together with the Vice Mayor and the concerned Sangguniang Bayan Members of Abuyog Leyte and discussed with them the findings of the committee. The committee suggested to revise or introduce certain amendments to subject ordinance particularly Section 6 thereof and submit the revised or amended ordinance to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan once it has been approved pursuant to the legislative process, which the Sangguninag Bayan of Abuyog agreed. The committee on that note also suggested that in relation to the purpose of their Municipal Ordinance No. 2, series of 2021, which is to enable their LGU to have additional revenues, the Sangguninag Bayan of Abuyog should also refer to Sec. 147,⁵ 153⁶ and 444 of the Local Government Code. These sections of the Local Government Code allow LGUs to collect fees and other charges as they see fit; provided, the same shall not be unjust, excessive, oppressive, confiscatory or contrary to declared national policy pursuant to Sec 186⁷ of the same Code.

⁵ SEC. 147. Fees and Charges. - The municipality may impose and collect such reasonable fees and charges on business and occupation and, except as reserved to the province in Section 139 of this Code, on the practice of any profession or calling, commensurate with the cost of regulation, inspection and licensing before any person may engage in such business or occupation, or practice such profession or calling.

⁶ SEC. 153. Service Fees and Charges. - Local government units may impose and collect such reasonable fees and charges for services rendered.

⁷ SEC. 186. Power To Levy Other Taxes, Fees or Charges. - Local government units may exercise the power to levy taxes, fees or charges on any base or subject not otherwise specifically enumerated herein or taxed under the provisions of the National Internal Revenue Code, as amended, or other applicable laws: Provided, That the taxes, fees, or charges shall not be unjust, excessive, oppressive, confiscatory or contrary to declared national policy: Provided, further, That the ordinance levying such taxes, fees or charges shall not be enacted without any prior public hearing conducted for the purpose.

- 1276 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: TEMP. PRESIDING OFFICER/5TH DIST. BOARD MEMBER
- 1277 May we hear from the Chairman of the Blue Ribbon Committee?
- 1278 HON. RONNAN CHRISTIAN M. REPOSAR, JR.: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER
- 1279 Yes, thank you very much Honorable Chair.
- 1280 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: TEMP. PRESIDING OFFICER/5TH DIST. BOARD MEMBER
- 1281 Welcome.
- 1282 HON. RONNAN CHRISTIAN M. REPOSAR, JR.: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER
- 1283 I've written the Provincial Legal Office actually, just for me to be clarified, of
- 1284 course, in relation to the case which was referred to the Blue Ribbon Committee. And

1285 with the readings I've been doing of some procedures that are applicable to the case.
1286 Perusing the rules and procedures of this August Body, Mr. Chair, after an answer has
1287 been received the case would be re-scheduled for a preliminary conference through the
1288 Sangguniang Panlalawigan Secretary and called for by the Presiding Officer. That's
1289 where my confusion actually comes because, I don't know, after having gathered some
1290 information particularly on the status of the respondents, Mr. Chair, I think only three of
1291 the seven or nine respondents are still incumbent.

1292 The letter of Provincial Legal Office through Atty. Acol provides that we retain
1293 jurisdiction because of the abandonment of the condonation doctrine of Carpio-Morales
1294 case, Mr. Chair, which I agree. However, it is recommended that our guidance for the
1295 penalties would be Rule 11 of Administrative Order No. 23. Rule 11 of Administrative
1296 Order only provides to penalties which is suspension and removal. And under a case
1297 which was passed by the Supreme Court of the Philippines, on the case of the
1298 Sangguniang Barangay Don Mariano Marcos, Sebastian, et al., versus Severino
1299 Martinez, it provided that the penalty of removal is only vested, the authority to remove
1300 is actually vested to the courts only. So, we are now limited to the suspension. And
1301 according to Atty. Acol, even if the severe administrative sanctions may not be anymore
1302 imposed, we can still continue with the hearing and impose an administrative offense
1303 penalty like the disqualification to hold any government office. I've been reading a lot of
1304 several jurisprudence already, disqualification to hold any government office and
1305 forfeiture of benefits is actually accessory penalty of a removal. And I think the
1306 Sangguniang Panlalawigan does not have that kind of authority to withhold or forfeit the
1307 benefits of a certain elective government official. And with that, it would only be limited
1308 to the penalty of suspension the severest among the severe penalties.

1309 With that, Mr. Chair, I'd like to request or at least ask for a clarification how to
1310 proceed after having all these information, particularly referring to Section 54 of our
1311 Rules of Procedure which says that "collective consultation in arriving at a conclusion
1312 particularly provides that Sangguniang Panlalawigan conclusion or decision in any
1313 administrative cases submitted to it for decision, shall be reached in consultation before

1314 the case is assigned to a member for writing of the opinion.” While I’m not referring to
1315 the three incumbent respondents, I’d like to at least suggest that we already make a
1316 decision or a conclusion referring to those who are not anymore incumbent government
1317 officials who are respondents to the case, so that we could proceed smoothly with the
1318 hearing and accepting the evidences of the three other incumbents if in the event as I
1319 see, we could no longer proceed with the investigation referring to the respondents who
1320 are not now seating as incumbent government officials, Mr. Chair.

1321 So, my question is how do we proceed from here? Although I can actually write a
1322 summary of the case to facilitate and help the other members, I’d like to request if we
1323 could convene or the Blue Ribbon Committee can convene somehow come up with a
1324 recommendation which could be submitted through a committee report to the
1325 Sangguniang Panlalawigan for consideration, Mr. Chair.

1326 HON. CARLO P. LORETO:TEMP. PRESIDING OFFICER/5TH DIST. BOARD MEMBER

1327 Okay. Basta ikaw mag sering boss.

1328 Actually, there are competing views, ‘no. I think it was in Miriam Santiago’s book
1329 where she said that “the Sangguniang Bayan can actually dismiss or terminate
1330 employment of government employees.” And then, there is also a case it says that “it’s
1331 the governing law”, like it was a case of policemen. They cannot be terminated or
1332 suspended by the Sangguniang Bayan because they are governed by the PNP law. So,
1333 the views are divided and ... hin o an author han Local Government Code nga
1334 makapal? He says nga “suspension” la. So, it’s unchartered territory.

1335 HON. RONNAN CHRISTIAN M. REPOSAR: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1336 Yes.

1337 HON. CARLO P. LORETO:TEMP. PRESIDING OFFICER/5TH DIST. BOARD MEMBER

1338 Perhaps the Honorable Reposar can help jurisprudence.

1339 HON. RONNAN CHRISTIAN M. REPOSAR: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1340 Actually, jurisprudence cited Article 60 of the Local Government Code, and the
1341 last paragraph which provides that only the court can impose the penalty of removal
1342 which is reiterated in this case, the Sangguniang Barangay versus Punong Barangay

1343 Severino Martinez which also invalidated Section 125 of the Implementing Rules and
1344 Regulations of 7160. Because both Administrative Order No. 23 and Implementing
1345 Rules of the Local Government Code provides that removal can actually be imposed by
1346 the disciplining authority. So, that's actually where the confusion comes, Mr. Chair.

1347 So, with that, Mr. Chair, just for a clarification, I'll just convene the Blue Ribbon
1348 Committee and at least discuss the matter for us to be able to come up with a
1349 committee report for the consideration of the plenary.

1350 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: TEMP. PRESIDING OFFICER/5TH DIST. BOARD MEMBER

1351 Yes, as Chairman you have blanket authority to convene the committee anytime.

1352 HON. RONNAN CHRISTIAN M. REPOSAR: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1353 Sege. Thank you very much.

1354 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: TEMP. PRESIDING OFFICER/5TH DIST. BOARD MEMBER

1355 Do we have a motion for this?

1357 This is just for information, Mr. Chair, because we might be asked by the
1358 Ombudsman about the status of this case. So, I'm actually worried since the
1359 Ombudsman actually does follow-up on the status of the case. So, at least the
1360 Secretariat could inform them that this is now being undertaken by the committee.

1373 resolution or notice asking the respondents to file their respective answers have been
1374 received?

1375 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: TEMP. PRESIDING OFFICER/5TH DIST. BOARD MEMBER

1376 Okay. The Secretariat will check utro hadto 'no, kon ano an mga na received, an
1377 mga summons.

1378 HON. RONNAN CHRISTIAN M. REPOSAR: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

1379 The dates are actually important. Anyway, if the Secretariat cannot... would still
1380 have to go to the records, I'll just have to ask my staff to coordinate with the Secretariat,
1381 Mr. Chair.

1382 HON. CARLO P. LORETO: TEMP. PRESIDING OFFICER/5TH DIST. BOARD MEMBER

1383 There are no more Items in the agenda. First thing, we have a new Executive
1384 Secretary, former Chief Justice Lucas Bersamin. Would the illustrious gentleman from
1385 Palo be amenable to file a motion to congratulate?

1425 Mr. Chair, can we have a communication regarding that request which I was

1426 asking, so it would come out formal.

1428 For the session. Okay. We can agree seguro and then ig upod na la an ELA nga

1429 hotel, i request na la. Or an usa ka suggestion, maabot kita ha October 4 arrival in

1430 Manila in the morning, travel to Tagaytay and then check-in, lunch at Twin Lakes Hotel,
1431 and then session, and then after session, mga 4:00 p.m. session and then dinner.

1432 I noticed in Tagaytay they have several outlet stores. It will be an injustice if we
1433 will not check the outlet stores. Benchmarking 'no. Especially Tita Carmen and Tita
1434 Ebbie, they will survey because it's unfair for the outlet stores if they do not check. And
