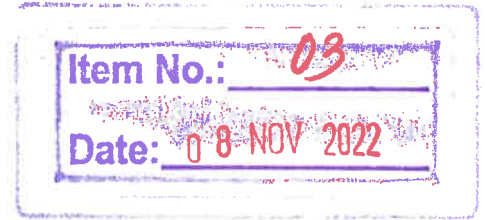

WHEREAS, the Active Fishers Association is a civil society organization duly registered with the Department of Labor and Employment, and existing under Philippines Laws;




