ORDINANCE NO. 2022- 04

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE LOCAL ANTI- CRIMINALITY ACTION PLAN FOR CRIME OF MURDER ( LACAP C. Y. 2023- 01 FOR MURDER ) IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF CALUBIAN, LEYTE.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Calubian, Leyte, in a session assembled, that :

**SECTION 1. TITLE.** *This Ordinance shall be known as " AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE LOCAL ANTI- CRIMINALITY ACTION PLAN FOR CRIME OF MURDER ( LACAP C. Y. 2023- 01 FOR MURDER ) IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF CALUBIAN, LEYTE."*

**SECTION 2. RATIONALE OF THE ORDINANCE .**

**A. Police Major Edwin D. Tolibas, Acting Chief of Police of Calubian, Leyte has formulated on Sept. 16, 2022 the Calubian Police Station Anti-Criminality Plan for the Crime of Murder ; and the same was submitted to the Honorable Sangguniang Bayan of the municipality for its favorable consideration & adoption ;**

**B. The same Anti-Criminality Plan for Crime of Murder has been formulated by the Calubian Police Station thru Police Major Edwin D. Tolibas , laid out the strategies to be undertaken by the personnel of the Calubian PNP on crime prevention, control and suppression in the total fight against all forms of criminality with the active support of the community ;**

**C. The same LOCAL ANTI- CRIMINALITY ACTION PLAN formulated by the Calubian Police Station also aims to reduce/ prevent crimes particularly, the crime against persons/ property and reduce the incidents such as shooting which result the untimely death of individuals**

**D. The said LOCAL ANTI- CRIMINALITY ACTION PLAN formulated will likewise help to improve crime solution efficiency, improve response time and religious implement E-MPO concept being the primary strategy of the PNP;**

**E. Section 447 (a)(1)of the Local Government Code of 1991 ( R. A. 7160 ) provides that xxx The Sangguniang Bayan shall approve ordinances and pass resolutions necessary for an efficient and effective municipal government, and in this connection shall: xxx**

**(ii) Maintain peace and order by enacting measures to prevent and suppress lawlessness, disorder, riot, violence, rebellion or sedition and impose penalties for the violation of said ordinances; xxx and**

**F. Section 24 of R. A. No. 6975 has expressly stipulated the Powers and Functions of the Members of Philippine National Police (PNP), to include the members of the Calubian PNP, xxx some of which are :**

- (a) Enforce all laws and ordinances relative to the protection of lives and properties;**
- (b) Maintain peace and order and take all necessary steps to ensure public safety; xxx**

**G. Section 52 of the Criminal Code of the Philippines clearly defines " Murder " as a crime, means any person who shall kill another, under the circumstances enumerated under this Code.**

**I. REFERENCES:**

- a. NHQ PNP LOI 71/08 "PAYAPA" (Decentralizing the formulation of Anti-Criminality Action Plan);
- b. NHQ PNP LOI 70/80 "Local Anti-Crime Strategy";
- c. Enhanced Managing Police Operations (EMPO)

**II. PURPOSE:**

In coordination with Local Government Unit (LGU), Department of Interior and Local Government Unit (DILG) this plan shall serve as the Action Plan in which all plans and programs of the Calubian Police Station shall conform with and supplement. In connection with the alarming increase of shooting incidents and death of individuals in the area especially in the far plunge barangays which remain unsolved this Local Anti-Criminality Action Plan for Murder, helps to avoid similar incident if not, at least to decreased its occurrence.

It shall prescribe the grand strategy to be undertaken by the personnel of this office on crime prevention, control and suppression, in the total fight against all forms of criminality.

**III. SITUATIONS:**

The campaign against Murder and other related crimes is a continuing concern. It is a war that the police cannot win alone, and cannot in any real sense fight alone. Police cannot change the "root drivers" of the crime such as poverty, unemployment, dysfunctional liberties and other ills of socio-economic opportunities. Thus, all aspects of police work should be premised upon active community consent, trust and participation.

In so doing, developing effective crime prevention, control and suppression strategies has presented the Calubian Police Station with a fundamental dilemma. On one hand, crime will always be committed and, indeed, a continuing mandate. From this perspective, the police are viewed solely as a professional crime buster. Likewise, one of the contributory factors in the proliferation of crime incidents in AOR is due to depletion of Calubian PNP personnel, lack of seminar of BPATs, Barangay Tanods as front liner in the Barangay level and lack of community awareness and concerns especially on how to prevent similar incident. Thus, the Calubian Police Station has been compelled to rethink and redesign its entire approach to this main task through clearer prioritization of targets with emphasis on prevention, control and suppression of crime and more resources moved into proactive policing.

The support and cooperation of all sectors concerned is therefore necessary to address these concerns. The increase of shooting incidents which result to Murder cases in our area of responsibility will cause percussions on the peace and order if not properly addressed.

#### IV. MISSION:

Calubian Police Station concurrently with its present function and mission and in coordination with Local Government agencies and Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) shall implement a responsive and holistic strategy to effectively prevent, control and suppress the occurrence of shooting incident (murder) or other related crimes, to insure safety in our community.

#### V. OBJECTIVES:

1. To reduce/prevent crimes particularly in crime against persons/property and reduce the incidents such as shooting which result the untimely death of individuals
2. To improve response time.
3. Improve crime solution efficiency.
4. Religiously implementation of E-MPO concept being the primary strategy of the PNP.

#### VI. EXECUTIONS:

##### A. Concept of Operations

##### 1. Strategic Concept

##### a. Improve the Police Security Service Package

- 1.) Utilization of all Calubian Police assets on the ground by adopting the Police Security Containment Ring System (PSCRS) composed of the following five (5) major components, deployment of which depends on their availability and the situation on the ground:
  - a.) The Innermost Containment Ring, which is composed of barangay tanods, CVO'S NGO'S, radio groups (Barangay Intelligence Network who shall assist, monitor and feed information to the police effect arrest through citizen arrest.
  - b.) The Inner Containment Ring, composed of the foot/beat, patrol elements in uniform for police visibility, if feasible a detective patrol in "civilian" attire for police presence. Even if there are no uniformed police around the people will still think that a police eye is watching them. Duty personnel of day and night patrol shall conduct mobile patrol to the crime prone areas.
  - c.) The third component is the Middle Containment Ring, which is composed of motorcycle patrols at the crime prone areas. Issued motorcycle from LGU or PNP, and the available service motorcycle of the PNP personnel on duty shall be utilized to be provided with adequate gas allocation.
  - d.) The forth Containment Ring is composed of Check Point, Choke Point, Drag Net Operation and Mobile Patrol. The task is to prevent the escape of fleeing criminals and react or respond to a call for police assistance.

Rule 25 of Philippine National Police Operational Procedures, The establishment of checkpoints must always be authorized by the PNP and manned by uniformed PNP personnel assigned in the area. Other units directly involved in an operation may establish mobile checkpoints in coordination with the Commander of the Unit/Station in the area.

e.) The Fifth is the Outermost Containment Ring; the PNP Sub Station shall serve as security elements where they can immediately react to call for armed support to depleted police personnel on the ground.

2.) Crime Situation Map, it will be indicated in the map the place and time of crime incident happened for easy monitoring of crime prone areas in AOR.

3.) Deployment of dedicated intelligence and investigation operatives to conduct legal offensive and timely information against the presence of lawless elements and other criminals.

b. Strengthen linkages with NGOs.

c. Enhancement of the community through the active participation of trusted BINs and Eye of the Barangays organized and their NGO Communication Groups like KABALIKAT CIVICOM.

d. Operationalization of the Integrated Area/Community Public Safety Plan (IACPS)

e. Enhance effective Feedback Mechanism-encourage the community to report any information or presence of NPA/CTGs through call or by texting directly to the chief of Police and/or calling the recent Office Hotline number of the Calubian Police Station or contact any PNP officer for immediate respond.

B. Tasks:

a.) Chief of Police – Overall group supervisor, responsible in the successful implementation of this Action Plan.

b.) Deputy Chief of Police – shall assist and or take charge in the implementation of this plan in the absence of the COP.

- Perform other task as necessary

c.) Duty Officers of the Day (Day/Night Patrol – shall supervise, manage and control all duty personnel in the implementation of this plan.

- Perform other task as necessary

d.) Team Leaders (Day/Night Patrol) – shall directly lead his team members in the implementation of this plan.


- Perform other task as necessary


e.) Patrol Members – shall religiously perform their duties;


- Concentrate on Day and Night Patrol Operations in areas where crime prone.

- Facilitate the conduct of seminars on drug and drunken awareness that trigger to do said incident.

- (Other operational efforts); and
- Perform other task as necessary.

g.) Intelligence Section

- Provide timely and accurate intelligence information;
- Maintain updated list on suspected persons/crime groups involved in any criminal activities in AOR;

- (Other intelligence efforts); and
- Perform other task as necessary.

h.) Investigation Section

- Conduct speedy investigation and prosecution of all cases related to shooting and other related cases that resulted to murder.

- (Other investigation efforts); and
- Perform other task as necessary.

i.) PCR Section

- Conduct public information campaign in coordination with the Municipal Public Information Officer, in order to raise public awareness and generate community supports.

- Coordinate with all Barangay Captains for the mobilization of Tanods and BIN members in all Barangays as force multipliers.

- Conduct training for Barangay Tanods/Police in information gathering efforts and reporting.

- Invite resource persons to conduct seminars and information drive on drug and drunken awareness and other related activities that educate individuals in order to avoid/prevent in doing similar incidents.

- (Other police-community relation efforts); and
- Perform other task as necessary.

j.) Supply PNCO

- Provide equipment and Logistical support to the operating personnel and ensure that all patrol vehicle in good condition.

- Perform other task as necessary.

- Provide appropriate number of personnel as augmentation as requested if necessary to Calubian Police Station during the conduct of Anti-Criminality driven operation, apprehend and service of warrant arrest for Murder cases suspect; and,
- Perform other task as necessary as COP may direct.

5.) Municipal Health Office

- Provide ambulance with crew on standby at the Municipal Hall during the conduct of Anti-criminality operations; and,
- Perform other task as necessary.

6.) Municipal Radio Communication Office

- Provide radio communications assistance; and
- Perform other task as necessary.

7.) Barangay Chairman

- Provide timely information on suspected presence of strangers/individuals in their respective barangays and to report any information regarding any unusual activities of strangers.

8.) Store Owners and Other Business Operators

- Provide timely information to Calubian Police Station any suspected persons and or strangers who have suspicious actions in their respective business establishments.

9.) Calubian Police Station

- Convene the council members for inputs and subsequent approval of the Anti-Criminality Action Plan for Murder taking into consideration the responsibility of all concerned for a holistic and effective approach to the crime situation in suitable time for this activity; and


10.) Calubian Sangguniang Bayan (CSB)


- Enact ordinances for the adoption of the MPOC-APPROVED Anti-Criminality action plan, for the provision of funding and support for its implementation, to include the training and mobilization of Barangay Tanods/Police as force multipliers.

- Enact other ordinances as may be necessary or when the need arises, for the effective implementation of the plan.


**VII. COORDINATING INSTRUCTIONS:**

- c. Enhanced Managing Police Operations (EMPO)

**II. PURPOSE:**

In coordination with Local Government Unit (LGU), Department of Interior and Local Government Unit (DILG) this plan shall serve as the Action Plan in which all plans and programs of the Calubian Police Station shall conform with and supplement. In connection with the alarming increase of shooting incidents and death of individuals in the area especially in the far plunge barangays which remain unsolved this Local Anti-Criminality Action Plan for Murder, helps to avoid similar incident if not, at least to decreased its occurrence.

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The campaign against Murder and other related crimes is a continuing concern. It is a war that the police cannot win alone, and cannot in any real sense fight alone. Police cannot change the "root drivers" of the crime such as poverty, unemployment, dysfunctional liberties and other ills of socio-economic opportunities. Thus, all aspects of police work should be premised upon active community consent, trust and participation.

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fundamental dilemma. On one hand, crime will always be committed and, indeed, a continuing mandate. From this perspective, the police are viewed solely as a professional crime buster. Likewise, one of the contributory factors in the proliferation of crime incidents in AOR is due to depletion of Calubian PNP personnel, lack of seminar of BPATs, Barangay Tanods as front liner in the Barangay level and lack of community awareness and concerns especially on how to prevent similar incident. Thus, the Calubian Police Station has been compelled to rethink and redesign its entire approach to this main task through clearer prioritization of targets with emphasis on prevention, control and suppression of crime and more resources moved into proactive policing.

The support and cooperation of all sectors concerned is therefore necessary to address these concerns. The increase of shooting incidents which result to Murder cases in our area of responsibility will cause percussions on the peace and order if not properly addressed.

#### **IV. MISSION:**

Calubian Police Station concurrently with its present function and mission and in coordination with Local Government agencies and Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) shall implement a responsive and holistic strategy to effectively prevent, control and suppress the occurrence of shooting incident (murder) or other related crimes, to insure safety in our community.

#### **V. OBJECTIVES:**

1. To reduce/prevent crimes particularly in crime against persons/property and reduce the incidents such as shooting which result the untimely death of individuals
2. To improve response time.
3. Improve crime solution efficiency.
4. Religiously implementation of E-MPO concept being the primary strategy of the PNP.

#### **VI. EXECUTIONS:**

##### **A. Concept of Operations**

##### **1. Strategic Concept**

##### **a. Improve the Police Security Service Package**

- 1.) Utilization of all Calubian Police assets on the ground by adopting the Police Security Containment Ring System (PSCRS) composed of the following five (5) major components, deployment of which depends on their availability and the situation on the ground:

- a.) The Innermost Containment Ring, which is composed of barangay tanods, CVO'S NGO'S, radio groups (Barangay Intelligence



Network who shall assist, monitor and feed information to the police effect arrest through citizen arrest.

- b.) The Inner Containment Ring, composed of the foot/beat, patrol elements in uniform for police visibility, if feasible a detective patrol in "civilian" attire for police presence. Even if there are no uniformed police around the people will still think that a police eye is watching them. Duty personnel of day and night patrol shall conduct mobile patrol to the crime prone areas.
  - c.) The third component is the Middle Containment Ring, which is composed of motorcycle patrols at the crime prone areas. Issued motorcycle from LGU or PNP, and the available service motorcycle of the PNP personnel on duty shall be utilized to be provided with adequate gas allocation.
  - d.) The fourth Containment Ring is composed of Check Point, Choke Point, Drag Net Operation and Mobile Patrol. The task is to prevent the escape of fleeing criminals and react or respond to a call for police assistance.
- Rule 25 of Philippine National Police Operational Procedures, The establishment of checkpoints must always be authorized by the PNP and manned by uniformed PNP personnel assigned in the area. Other units directly involved in an operation may establish mobile checkpoints in coordination with the Commander of the Unit/Station in the area.
- e.) The Fifth is the Outermost Containment Ring; the PNP Sub Station shall serve as security elements where they can immediately react to call for armed support to depleted police personnel on the ground.
- 2.) Crime Situation Map, it will be indicated in the map the place and time of crime incident happened for easy monitoring of crime prone areas in AOR.
  - 3.) Deployment of dedicated intelligence and investigation operatives to conduct legal offensive and timely information against the presence of lawless elements and other criminals.
- b. Strengthen linkages with NGOs.
  - c. Enhancement of the community through the active participation of trusted BINs and Eye of the Barangays organized and their NGO Communication Groups like KABALIKAT CIVICOM.
  - d. Operationalization of the Integrated Area/Community Public Safety Plan (IA/CPSP)
  - e. Enhance effective Feedback Mechanism-encourage the community to report any information or presence of NPA/CTGs through call or by texting

directly to the chief of Police and/or calling the recent Office Hotline number of the Calubian Police Station or contact any PNP officer for immediate respond.

**B. Tasks:**

a.) Chief of Police – Overall group supervisor, responsible in the successful implementation of this Action Plan.

b.) Deputy Chief of Police – shall assist and or take charge in the implementation of this plan in the absence of the COP.

- Perform other task as necessary

c.) Duty Officers of the Day (Day/Night Patrol – shall supervise, manage and control all duty personnel in the implementation of this plan.

- Perform other task as necessary

d.) Team Leaders (Day/Night Patrol) – shall directly lead his team members in the implementation of this plan.

- Perform other task as necessary

e.) Patrol Members – shall religiously perform their duties;

- Concentrate on Day and Night Patrol Operations in areas where crime prone.

- Closely monitor on the target personalities on watch list.

- Apprehend all violators of the laws and ordinances.

- Adhere to the Rule of Law in implementation of Arrest, search and Seizures.

- Perform other task as necessary.

f.) Operations PNCO

- OPR in the formulation and operationalization of this Action Plan;

- Deploy appropriate number of personnel to conduct foot/beat/motorcycle/mobile patrol/police visibility in the crime prone areas.

- Facilitate the conduct of seminars on drug and drunken awareness that trigger to do said incident.

- (Other operational efforts); and

- Perform other task as necessary.

**g.) Intelligence Section**

- Provide timely and accurate intelligence information;
- Maintain updated list on suspected persons/crime groups involved in any criminal activities in AOR;
- (Other intelligence efforts); and
- Perform other task as necessary.

**h.) Investigation Section**

- Conduct speedy investigation and prosecution of all cases related to shooting and other related cases that resulted to murder.
- (Other investigation efforts); and
- Perform other task as necessary.

**i.) PCR Section**

- Conduct public information campaign in coordination with the Municipal Public Information Officer, in order to raise public awareness and generate community supports.
- Coordinate with all Barangay Captains for the mobilization of Tanods and BIN members in all Barangays as force multipliers.
- Conduct training for Barangay Tanods/Police in information gathering efforts and reporting;
- Invite resource persons to conduct seminars and information drive on drug and drunken awareness and other related activities that educate individuals in order to avoid/prevent in doing similar incidents.
- (Other police-community relation efforts); and
- Perform other task as necessary.

**j.) Supply PNCO**

- Provide equipment and Logistical support to the operating personnel and ensure that all patrol vehicle in good condition.
- Perform other task as necessary.

**k.) Finance PNCO**

- Provide the necessary fund support needed in the implementation of this plan (coordinate with LGU for possible support).
- Perform other task as necessary.

**4.) 19 IB, Philippine Army**

- Provide appropriate number of personnel as augmentation as requested if necessary to Calubian Police Station during the conduct of Anti-Criminality driven operation, apprehend and service of warrant arrest for Murder cases suspect; and,
- Perform other task as necessary as COP may direct.

**5.) Municipal Health Office**

- Provide ambulance with crew on standby at the Municipal Hall during the conduct of Anti-criminality operations; and,
- Perform other task as necessary.

**6.) Municipal Radio Communication Office**

- Provide radio communications assistance; and
- Perform other task as necessary.

**7.) Barangay Chairman**

- Provide timely information on suspected presence of strangers/individuals in their respective barangays and to report any information regarding any unusual activities of strangers.

**8.) Store Owners and Other Business Operators**

- Provide timely information to Calubian Police Station any suspected persons and or strangers who have suspicious actions in their respective business establishments.

**9.) Calubian Police Station**

- Convene the council members for inputs and subsequent approval of the Anti-Criminality Action Plan for Murder taking into consideration the responsibility of all concerned for a holistic and effective approach to the crime situation in suitable time for this activity; and

**10.) Calubian Sangguniang Bayan (CSB)**

- Enact ordinances for the adoption of the MPOC-APPROVED Anti-Criminality action plan, for the provision of funding and support for its implementation, to include the training and mobilization of Barangay Tanods/Police as force multipliers.

- Enact other ordinances as may be necessary or when the need arises, for the effective implementation of the plan.


**VII. COORDINATING INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Respect for human rights shall be paramount and strict adherence with the PNP Operational Procedure (Rules of Engagement) shall always be emphasized in all operations.
2. Adherence to the rule of law is required.
3. All operating personnel shall render reports directly to COP.
4. Apprehended target personalities shall immediately be brought to Calubian Police Station for proper disposition.
5. Maximum coordination with LGU, NGO and all sectors of the community, for the success of this plan is authorized and highly encouraged.

**VIII. EFFECTIVITY:**

This Action Plan takes effect on **January 03, 2023** upon approval.



The undersigned Chairman, Vice Chairman & Members of the COMMITTEE ON LAW ENFORCEMENT AND PEACE & ORDER respectfully submit to the Honorable August Body, the following committee findings:

A. Police Major Edwin D. Tolibas, Acting Chief of Police of Calubian, Leyte has formulated on Sept. 16, 2022 the Calubian Police Station Anti-Criminality Plan for the Crime of Murder ; and the same was submitted to the Honorable Sangguniang Bayan of the municipality for its favorable consideration & adoption ;

B. The same Anti-Criminality Plan for Crime of Murder has been formulated by the Calubian Police Station thru Police Major Edwin D. Tolibas , laid out the strategies to be undertaken by the personnel of the Calubian PNP on crime prevention, control and suppression in the total fight against all forms of criminality with the active support of the community ;

C. The same LOCAL ANTI- CRIMINALITY ACTION PLAN formulated by the Calubian Police Station also aims to reduce/ prevent crimes particularly in crime against persons or incidents related to destruction of life which result to the untimely death of individuals.

D. The said LOCAL ANTI- CRIMINALITY ACTION PLAN formulated will likewise help to improve crime solution efficiency, improve response time and religious implement E-MPO concept being the primary strategy of the PNP;

E. Section 447 (a)(1) of the Local Government Code of 1991 ( R. A. 7160 ) provides that xxx The Sangguniang Bayan shall approve ordinances and pass resolutions necessary for an efficient and effective municipal government, and in this connection shall: xxx

(ii) Maintain peace and order by enacting measures to prevent and suppress lawlessness, disorder, riot, violence, rebellion or sedition and impose penalties for the violation of said ordinances; xxx


F. Section 24 of R. A. No. 6975 has expressly stipulated the Powers and Functions of the Members of Philippine National Police (PNP), to include the members of the Calubian PNP, xxx some of which are :

- (a) Enforce all laws and ordinances relative to the protection of lives and properties;
- (b) Maintain peace and order and take all necessary steps to ensure public safety; xxx

G. The proposed municipal ordinance which will be formulated by this Honorable August Body does not, however entail a penalty; hence, the conduct of a Public Hearing is no longer necessary;

WHEREFORE, we shall look forward for the approval of this committee report and recommend for the approval of the proposed Ordinance No. 2022- 04 , " AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE LOCAL ANTI- CRIMINALITY ACTION PLAN FOR CRIME OF MURDER ( LACAP C. Y. 2023- 01 FOR MURDER ) ) IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF CALUBIAN, LEYTE."
