

### Gentlemen and Ladies:

Pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160), our preliminary review of the **General Fund Supplemental Budget No. 01 FY 2022** of the **Municipality of Tunga**, **Leyte** duly enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan through **Appropriation Ordinance No. 2**, **Series of 2022** with a total appropriation in the amount of **P2,543,536.93** reveals compliance with the same law and its implementing Rules and Regulations.

It is therefore recommended for approval subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That the creation of additional positions to implement the devolved basic services and functions are those reflected in the approved Devolution Transition Plan (DTP) of the LGU, specifically Annex I (Proposed Additional Positions to the Plantiila of LGU Personnel) of DBM-DILG JMC No. 1 dated August 11, 2021. Moreover, the waived PS items pursuant to Local Budget Circular No. 145 shall only be implemented in FY 2022. Hence, said creation of positions shall be subject to PS limitation in FY 2023 and years thereafter;
- 2. That the grant of Representation and Transportation Allowance shall conform with the provisions of Local Budget Circular No. 103;
- 3. That the appropriation of PhilHealth Contributions shall follow the premium rate of 4.0% for CY 2022 pursuant to PhilHealth Circular 2019-009 on the Premium Contribution Schedule in the National Health Insurance program pursuant to R.A. No. 11223 known as the Universal Health Care Act;
- 4. That disbursement of funds shall be for the specific purpose(s) for which they have been appropriated pursuant to Sections 335 & 336 of RA 7160.

Compliance with CSC rules, DBM issuances, and accounting and auditing rules and regulations and all other existing laws shall be the responsibility of the implementing Local Government Unit.

### **RESOLUTION NO. 2022-041**

A RESOLUTION ENACTING THE 2022 GENERAL FUND SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 1 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TUNGA, LEYTE IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO MILLION FIVE HUNDRED FORTY-THREE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY-SIX PESOS AND NINETY-THREE CENTAVOS (PHP 2,543,536.93) PURSUANT TO SECTION 447(a)(2)(i) OF R.A. 7160.

WHEREAS, Section 447(a)(2)(i) of R.A. 7160 empowers the Sangguniang Bayan to approved annual and supplemental budgets of the municipal government and appropriate funds for specific programs, projects, services and activities of the municipality, or for other purposes not contrary to law, in order to promote the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants;

WHEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Lemuel G. Ponferrada, duly seconded by Hon. Jose Capoporo A. Uribe, be it;

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to enact the following Appropriation Ordinance, to wit:

**APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 2** 

Series of 2022

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 1 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TUNGA, LEYTE, FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2022 IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO MILLION FIVE HUNDRED FORTY-THREE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY-SIX PESOS AND NINETY-THREE CENTAVOS (PHP 2,543,536.93).

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan, Tunga, Leyte that:

**Section 1.** The Supplemental Budget No. 1 of the Municipality of Tunga, Leyte for Calendar Year 2022 in the amount of Two Million Five Hundred Forty-Three Thousand Five Hundred Thirty-Six Pesos and Ninety-Three Centavos (Php 2,543,536.93) is hereby approved.

The Supplemental Budget documents consisting of the following are incorporated herein and made integral part of this Ordinance:

- 1. Certification of Availability of funds signed by the Acting Municipal Treasurer & Municipal Accountant
- 2. Statement of Funding Sources signed by the Acting Municipal Treasurer & Municipal Accountant.
- 3. Statement of Supplemental Appropriation prepared by the Municipal Budget Officer & approved by the Municipal Mayor.

Section 2. Sources of funds. The source of funds for Supplemental Budget No. 1 in the amount of Two Million Five Hundred Forty-Three Thousand Five Hundred Thirty-Six Pesos and Ninety-Three Centavos (Php 2,543,536.93) shall be from Savings (Unappropriated Balance/Surplus) 2021.

Section 3. Use of Funds. The amount of Php 2,543,536.93 is hereby appropriated for Supplemental Budget No. 1, CY 2022 of the Municipality of Tunga, Leyte.

**Section 5. Separability Clause.** If, for any reason, any section or provision of this ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, other sections or provisions thereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 6. Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
